**PUBLIC SPEAKS:** Tom Meister re: Is a member of the Harter Heights Area Neighborhood Association and was asked to speak on behalf of the Association. Over the summer and in the past, they held a landscape competition to encourage residents to maintain their properties. Believes this was a success and wants to encourage other neighborhood associations to do the same; Patricia Kirk re: Brought a tree cage that was found when a tree was dug in the City up by an arborist. Asking where the picnic tables are that were on the Kresge lot; Gloria Talarico re: Is a part of the Mayor's Literacy Commission. Advising that the Commission mans a samaritan's table that is housed at St. John's Church where they feed and help between 400 and 600 people every Thursday; Heather Curtice re: Discussing problem with easement and shared drive on Lawn Ave SW.

**<u>MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS</u>**: Member West re: Advising Patricia Kirk that he believes the Arcardia has some of the picnic tables that were being used for a fund raiser and will make certain that they get returned. Also asking if the City has a tree advisory committee; Law Director Martuccio re: Advising Member West that we have a tree Ordinance but it does not go as far as the model tree Ordinance that was worked on for awhile, which would include an actual tree commission; Member Kraus re: Wanted the record to show that the President of the OUR Group is Linda Poole. Also asking the Mayor or Safety Director to give an update on the cadet firemen that were laid off and the closing of the fire stations; Safety Director Ream re: Advising that they will be meeting with the fire fighter's Union Representatives on Thursday at 11:00 AM; Member Kraus re: Believes that there should be a meeting to look at possibly passing the closing of the Fire Stations around instead of one being closed more than others; President Schulman re: Discussing his recent question about raising the City Income Tax.
