PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Eric Resnick bringing good news regarding the Resolution from the spring to Keep Our Educators Working which passed the Senate last week and will pass the House today. This is a great thing for Canton City Schools. He wanted to thank Council for the ongoing support for honoring McGregor School. Mike Verbus is an executive board member for AFSCME opposing Ordinance 20, 21 and 22. The union members are not being paid for additional job duties so why should management get increased pay. All city employees should receive a wage increase before these new positions are added. Norm Druckenbrod was trying to exit the parade route on Saturday morning and turned down a street that had no signs indicating it was closed however, was stopped by an officer that told him he was on a closed street and needed to turn around. When turning around a cruiser came and gave him a ticket. He feels he was treated disrespectfully as he has never had a citation in 62 years and did not even receive a call back from the Mayor's office regarding this matter. John Hall has the positive issue that can help the children and the city but feels that it will be very negative if a water park is not established at the Southeast Community. The swimming pool may help to attract and compliment this business. Dick Deitrick agrees with John Hall about the need for activities for both children and adults in the city and would like to see the YMCA get back on track. He thinks the Police presence on I77 could be used in other areas for more important issues because people only go the speed limit when they see the police there, otherwise they are doing 70 to 75 on the highway and not causing a problem. Ray Sprankle drives a truck and has been stopped on I77 a few times recently for overload, debris falling from vehicle, short mud flaps, etc. The trucks from his company are inspected on a weekly basis and these accusations are not true and he feels they are being harassed. Kathryn Ramsey wanted to thank the person responsible for getting some vacant houses on her street boarded up. She thinks that the lots from homes that are demolished should be offered to other home owners since she takes care of some lots in her neighborhood. David Poole had an incident at the Blue's Festival regarding his service dog and has never received any response back on the issue. He would like contacted about this matter. Barb Gaskell is the General Manager for Living Bread Radio. She discussed Rita Rizzo who became Sister Angelica and on October 9th and 10th there will be a tribute to her life at the Canton Civic Center. This will be broadcast around the world on both cable TV and the radio.
