OLD BUSINESS (PUBLIC SPEAKS): None

PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Wayne Jamerson asks if the city has any control over the grass and weeds inside the building at the old Ohio Cast. The weeds outside are 6 feet tall but he thinks what is inside is causing a lot of mosquitoes in the area. He also wants the administration and Council to tell people the truth about never building a sprinkler park in the SE end of town. There is nothing for the kids to do and he doesn't feel the spray park will be built. Gary Oman has concerns with all of the issues at Ridgewood Castle Apts. There are drug dealers and users living there and openly selling and doing drugs in front of everyone including children. There are mice in the buildings and most of the hallways smell like urine. Something needs to be done with this complex. Jason Scaglione states that the intersection of Glen Place and Fawcett continues to flood every time there is a heavy rain. He has received reports that the area is in need of larger storm sewers to divert the run off from 25 acres of land. There is a garage in his area that doesn't have a door on it and the neighborhood kids are using it as a place to get high. After calling to report this, there still is no door on the garage. He wants to know why the city is not using the Police Dept motorcycles for the summer since these probably have high lease payments. Mr. Scaglione is still asking for answers about the availability of EMS crews. He just doesn't understand why someone can't be paid overtime to cover a shift for the prices they charge for transport. Robert Nichols is very sad about the Section 8 housing that is in his neighborhood. He does not feel that their inspectors are properly doing their jobs and are letting people move into homes that are not up to code standards. He and the neighbors in that area try to maintain a nice community and they will not stand for these types of run down homes to be in their neighborhood. Bruce Brewer is the President of the Vassar Park Neighborhood Association and he also has been experiencing problems with the Ridgewood Castle Apartments. He has made a couple of appointments with the management and they have cancelled all of them. The area is just rampant with drugs and now cars are being broken into, downspouts are being taken off homes, etc. It has taken him up to 10 days to get calls back from the Police Dept and he just feels the area has become lawless. The neighbors are connected to a mass email system for communication and they are not going away.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Cirelli asking how some residents can have dumpsters sitting on their property for long periods of time while they are full. Is there any rules that provide a time frame? Jason Reese will see if there is a time period for these or will be happy to help her establish an Ordinance for a time frame if she would like. Member Cirelli was upset that she was solicited by a gas supplier that she is not a customer with. Since she is on a Do Not Call list she asks how they would have a right to contact her. Jason Reese is not sure of the Do Not Call list regulations but thinks because the city is a part of a gas aggregate program, this gives them the right to call customers. President Schulman has been on both sides of incidents with the Police Department. He was commenting on all of the out of town emails that have come in regarding an issue with one of the officers and wanted to be on record stating that these people do not know our city or our people. The laws that allow people to carry concealed weapons in areas that are already filled with crimes such as drugs and prostitution will only lead to more problems and possible death of an officer or a citizen.
