Also discussed the need for a land banking program; Member Cirelli re: Asked what it costs per lot to mow because she saw a billboard that said mowing costs \$25.00 per lot of any size; Service Director Price re: Advised that the cost is approximately \$50.00 per lot but there are some larger lots and this includes all charges associated with the due process that the City has to serve; Member West re: Advising that on April 11th at 5:30 PM, he is starting a Ward 2 Neighborhood Executive Committee made up of Precinct Committeeman and Neighborhood Association Leaders, this is at 1000 12th Street. April 12th Stark County Minority Health will have its 9th annual dinner at Skyland Pines for \$5.00. April 21st will be B-Earth Day where they will gather at Nimisilla Park, cleaning, planting flowers and painting the tennis courts; Member Smith re: Advised Mr. Burt that she will work with him to get some lighting in his area.
