MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Fisher seen an article in the Cincinnati newspaper saying that Governor Kasich has promised to veto any attempt by a city to increase their local government funds that go toward the safety forces. This is a policy that has been in effect more than 50 years that he is now breaking against the Police and Fire Departments. Member Cirelli asks the Safety Director and the Assistant Law Director Smith if a person witnesses another person committing a crime and they were to take a picture with their phone, could this be used as evidence. Also, should we encourage or discourage this activity. Safety Director Ream says these photos can be very beneficial as evidence. Assistant Law Director Smith also says that if this matter comes to trial, photos are a good thing to have. Member Mariol thanked all Council Members and the Mayor for all of the assistance in his transition. He also thanked Pat Barton for his help in communicating any issues that were in progress. Mayor Healy responding that the source of revenue for high grass is difficult because the people that have walked away from their homes are not the people that are going to pay fines for mowing. The city can have people out writing citations all day long but if no one pays the fine, all we have done is increase our costs. He also took a moment to welcome Member Mariol.

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
