PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Pete DiGiacomo discussed newspaper article eliminating Council-at-Large positions. He is against this because of their help in closing a neighborhood bar. He does not think this is a positive change. Bruce Brewer represents Group 175. They are citizens and businesses that are determined to get 175 officers on the streets. Leroy Lynch thanked Director Price for working towards a method of having handicaps take Civil Service exams. He feels that some people who got a raise last week also have a very large pension. Kenneth King says he found 30 or 40 people in the midst of a large fight on Wertz Avenue. He is concerned about his neighborhood and wants to know what to do in a situation until police arrive because that can be a crucial time. Bruce Nordman says Group 175 will be meeting with the Mayor tomorrow and his feelings are and will remain that the Police Department needs to be staffed at 175. They feel arrests are down because staff is down. Ray Skotnicky lost his job over retire/rehire situation. He worked for the city for 36 years and at no time did he attempt to retire. He submitted paperwork from his supervisor to OPERS to claim benefits only. He stated that the appointing authorities were all aware of the persons that were receiving these benefits while remaining in their positions. The city officials had established a policy and procedure to encourage and recruit employees to take advantage of this. James Parker still wants the Ordinance regarding the fees for massage therapist to be abolished because it makes touching illegal. Kliff Speaker remarking about the Mayor's salary. If it is based on the population or the Consumer Price Index he is overpaid. Patricia Kirk wants the Board of Elections to remain in a downtown central location because of all of the work that is done there after voting is completed. Henry Preston states there is inappropriate use of equipment by city employees like receiving voicemail when calling into departments.
