OLD BUSINESS (PUBLIC SPEAKS): Reviewed Pending Issues from Public Speaks

PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Jonathan Bailey spoke about the vendor's license ordinance. He said it is ridiculous for downtown because it just shuts down free enterprise. He said he cannot open his own business because he cannot get a vendor's license. He feels it is a law that purposely keeps poor people poor and it needs to be changed. However, no one will listen to him because he has no money. Bruce Nordman provided council with a list of the 48 neighborhood associations, and explained that the phone numbers were removed because while they were supposed to be used for business purposes, the information leaked out to others. He advised council to contact the officers to get the information they needed. He recognized The Repository and WHBC as two assets in the City that are well represented and do a great job. He announced that Wednesday at 1:30 PM The Repository is sponsoring a free picnic lunch at the McKinley Monument and encouraged everyone to attend. Eugene Blakely spoke about the Canton Police Department. He said there was a shooting near his residence recently and he called the police. He feels that because he has a speech impediment they treat him like a kid and get smart with him. He is tired of getting such an attitude from the police department. Mary Bennett apologized for her attitude when she last spoke before Council. She thanked Member Morris for speaking with her and her daughter earlier this evening. She spoke again about the housing issue and the terrible situation with landlords and tenants. She cares about Canton and wants to see it improve for her daughter and the next generation. She said there are code violations, houses not being registered, landlords being given money by the City, and doing nothing to improve their properties. She said that people all over the City need to see improvements. Maria Bennett spoke about the condition of a rental that she and her sister wanted to rent. They put down the security deposit, and the day they were moving in the pipes burst and water was everywhere. The garage was full of mattresses and furniture, their was yard waste, and wires hanging in the basement. When Code inspected they told her if anyone had touched the electric box, they could have been killed. They moved back in with her mother at 1220 Worley Ave NW and found it was full of bed bugs. She has contacted Fair Housing and Legal Aid. Jeff Melton is the landlord and Global Core & Associates LLC is the owner. Jackie Austin spoke about the rental at 916 6th St NW. She moved here from Detroit and has had to keep moving because of the landlords. She recently received a 30 day notice to leave just because she has requested that repairs be done. She just wants to live safely and comfortably and wants the landlords held accountable. Lois Jacobson has written social issue plays for 30 years, and is now a member of Coming Together for Stark County. Their current project has employed the services of Dialogue on Diversity. They provide training, workshops, and seminars using real life experiences in Stark County. She feels that successful diversity makes Stark County a better place to live. She asked Council for help in getting the word out to their wards.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Smuckler said that the Property and Maintenance Code was changed so inspections would be complaint driven. However, from what the speakers tonight have said, that is not the case. He feels that if their issues are not being addressed as in the past and not because their complaint driven, then the code is not worth the paper it's written on. Deputy Mayor Williams plans to meet with Ms. Bennett after the meeting tonight, get information on all three cases, and report back to Council. Member West feels they need to revisit the landlord/tenant Ordinance and get tougher on landlords. Member Morris agrees. He feels that landlords should be required to have a license for each property, and if they're not doing their job, their license gets pulled. He said the current policies cannot be enforced. Member Hawk concurs with everyone and said the Property Maintenance Code was actually a step backwards. He feels the Code Department should be put back with the Health Department because Health can cite landlords into Court. Member Griffin announced that on June 11th at 6:00 PM there will be a dedication for Tim Trbovich in Field #3 at Willy Field. Member West thanked Lois Jacobson for all her work in bringing diversity to the City. President Schulman indicated that Ohio law does provide a defense against landlords. He also suggested that Council look at putting up bonds for licensing landlords. Deputy Mayor Williams reminded Council that June 4th is Community Development Day at the Civic Center where citizens can learn about various programs being offered, and asked Council to volunteer. He also announced that on June 9th at the Hall of Fame the Canton Improvement Corp. is sponsoring an event to discuss the Hall of Fame Village Project and tell local businesses how to participate. The fee is \$20.00.
