OLD BUSINESS (PUBLIC SPEAKS): None

PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Robin Johnson, the wife of Fred Johnson, said that her husband served as a community leader for fifty years. He opened the first black pharmacy in the area. She is requesting approval of the name change from Bruce Avenue SE to Fred Johnson Way SE. Lee Cote resides six blocks from #47 fire station which was closed about six months ago. He said that two young men were replacing brakes on a car when one of them got his leg pinned between the car and a truck. 9-1-1 was called, but they had to come all the way from 25<sup>th</sup> and Cleveland. Soon after the paramedics arrived another young man went into an epileptic fit and they had to administered aid to him. The young man with the injured leg had to wait until another ambulance arrived all the way from West Tusc and Raff. He said that many people think Ward 8 is a rich area, but it is just like the rest of the City, and he asked Council to find it in their budget or secure grants so the fire department may hire more firefighters. Jason Scaglione lives near Station 5 which has been closed. He said that many elderly people live near this location. He feels that this is very serious business and Council must do everything possible to keep their citizens safe. Pete DiGiacomo remarked about how long Council knew about the fire department being short handed. He said the same thing happened with the police department, and they found a grant to get the extra officers. He feels we must put those two safety services first and have our priorities in order, which falls in line with the budget. He ended by asking how much would a lawsuit cost? Sharon Johnson is in support of the name change from Bruce Avenue to Fred Johnson Way. She said that Fred was and still is an icon in the community. He was part of the TACKLE Neighborhood Association along with her. She said that while they had the same name they were not related, but received each other's mail. Fred was always smiling and always concerned for his fellow neighbors. She hopes everyone will remember him the same way. Pastor David Morgan spoke about the terrorist events of this past week. He said the attacks in France and Lebanon have made us suspicious of one another, which is fueled by broadcasts and propaganda leaving us in despair. He said that we have two opportunities that can make a difference. One is the Thanksgiving dinner at St. Paul's on November 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 P.M. where people may come and give thanks for the blessings we enjoy. The other is the local Speech and Debate Program at McKinley High School which teaches young people the art of rationale debate and offers growth for more mature thought processes.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Smuckler mentioned that The Repository listed debts by land owners who had not paid their taxes. Many of these names were landlords such as Mr. Filliez. He feels that since many of these back taxes are owed to the City our law department should go after these people with the county prosecutor. He said that many are repeat names who own ten to twelve properties. He reminded Council that for quite some time they've been told the fire department does not have enough manpower. He hopes that they can add more ambulance runs and have more fire stations open in the next administration. He feels it's his job to represent his constituents, and now is the time by keeping as many fire stations open as possible. Member Mack is very unhappy with the way Station 10 was closed. He feels the public should know before the closing and not after. If the Chief felt he was unable to keep the stations open, Member Mack feels he should have come to Council with a supplemental plan so they could stay open for the public. Member West asked how many firefighters were hired in the last two years, and the total number of firefighters as of January 1, 2015. Deputy Mayor Williams said he would have the exact numbers to him by morning. Member Mariol talked about the father in Lebanon who tackled the second bomber and was blown up trying to save others. His name is Adel Termos, and Member Mariol feels he deserves recognition. Member Hawk spoke about Communication #400 wherein he asked for a temporary budget which could be passed onto the next administration. He said that with a complete budget they may get a better grip on what they are facing next year and save duplication. He thanked everyone for their time and consideration. Law Director Martuccio announced that after the meeting, the Claims Committee would meet in Executive Session.
