MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member West shared news that the Rotary Club presented the Mayor with a \$50,000.00 check at the Market Square Committee meeting. This amount is in addition to the \$50,000.00 check previously presented to Council, bringing the total for soft costs up to \$175,000.00 for the Market Square Project. Member Dougherty asked that we return to Announcement of Committee Meetings to make sure everything was right. He wanted to know why C&ED was meeting because they had already voted on the Ordinance in 1st Reading. Member Morris stated that Member Smith meant to say Parks & Recreation because he neglected to call it. Member Smuckler stated that the grass is growing and he's sure it will be taken care of administratively but he's concerned about legally dealing with the people who don't care in the community. He doesn't think enough is being done legally to take care of the situation. He'd rather the Law Dept. find out who owns the properties and make the owners be responsible for the cuttings because the City shouldn't be in the grass cutting business. Member Dougherty said he received and email that the grass cutting will start May 9th and wondered why we wait so long. Deputy Mayor Williams said that he would look into the issue and report back to everyone by morning. Law Director Martuccio stated that there has been a series of meetings going on between the Administration, Service Director and the Street Superintendent to get the mowing co-ordinated. He also said that increasing the registration fees will lead to more Code Enforcement Inspectors, who will service the witnesses, which will lead to more convictions. They recently had a couple of convictions. They're also meeting to talk about more aggressive collections to not let some people slip by that have in the past. Due to furloughs, they're down to 2 full-time prosecutors and are trying to work around those issues. Member Hawk thanked the Police Dept., Fire Dept, and 2 of the Street Dept. workers, Kirt Fach and Joel Souliere, and a gentleman from the Local Ironworkers 550 who rescued a woman from a house that was on fire.
