MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Hawk referred Mr. Parker to Ordinance #12 which conveys city owned property to the Refuge of Hope for their expansion. He stated that the money given to the Chamber of Commerce is an investment, not an expense because they will bring businesses and opportunity to the city. Member West stated that he frequents the Refuge of Hope and that they run a nice operation. They often get blamed for the downtown panhandling, however none of those individuals actually stay at the Refuge. If they find out that someone is panhandling or harassing people downtown, that person is kicked out. He stated that they are often mischaracterized, and urged Council and the community to visit their operation. He stated that the Chamber of Commerce works around economic development, and often businesses want to talk with business people, not to government, which is a help. He thanked the Chamber for their efforts. Member Smuckler stated that in light of the upcoming Massillon/McKinley game, it is important that everyone support the only high school that's left here. He announced that there is a breakfast before the game on October 29th from 8:00 AM to noon at St. George Social Hall at 1122 Cherry Avenue. He has tickets available for \$10.00 a piece. Member Mack explained the rationale in voting for the Chamber grant. He said it comes down to what is our return on the investment. We must look at the economic benefits the Chamber has brought to the city, such as keeping Day, Ketterer law firm in Canton and the First Friday events. He thanked the Chamber for all they do.
