PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Julie Sparks spoke about Member Dougherty's 27 years of public service on Council. She quoted what she calls two Davidisms, one being "If you don't care who gets the credit, you'll get more done," and the other being "He who is organized is he who gets the resources." These are both good lessons. She also acknowledged his accomplishments in Ward 6 such as work with infrastructure, Habitat for Humanity, and the corridor project. She feels that although Member Dougherty may not be prefect, he's more than close enough for her. William Jones spoke about SeeClickFix, the computer program for reporting complaints within the city. He started using it in 2014, and would usually receive a response in less than a week. He is concerned that it now takes a lot longer. He also spoke about the property at 1226 Market Ave. N. which has needed a replacement handicap ramp for over a year following the Market Ave. project. He has spoken with the Engineering Department and was told that the ramp can't be finished until the fabrication process is complete. He believes something else needs to be addressed regarding this issue.
