BUDGET PRESENTATION

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Law Director Martuccio complimented Clerk Dougherty on his performance this evening and thanked him for his previous service. Service Director Bartos read a letter from Dr. David N. Linz to Street Superintendent Rorar commending employee, David Ballard, for assisting Dr. Linz following an auto accident. Director Bartos thanked Mr. Ballard for a job well done. (*Applause*) President Schulman commented that this was really nice to hear considering so much criticism of city employees, and that the commendation was well deserved. Law Director Martuccio gave a brief overview of the five "children" Ordinances to the "mother" TDD Ordinance that received their first reading this evening. He explained that three of them generate revenue, one is a Resolution expressing Council's intent to ask the County and SARTA to share some of the TIF money for the proposed projects, and the final one is a master auditing Ordinance which sets up a master account for the receipt of funds. All Ordinances have a sunset provision which is tied to the sunset provision in the original TDD Ordinance. He encourages Council to peruse theses Ordinances, and contact him with any questions. President Schulman thanked the Law Director, his staff, the Mayor and the Administration for all their work in getting that set up and arranged. Member Morris complimented Clerk Dougherty for his clean desk, and agreed that Clerk Dougherty was the best Council Member ever.
