#### **OLD BUSINESS (PUBLIC SPEAKS): None**

PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Lisa Bussey expressed concern over the recent shootings between Gibbs and Spring Avenue, and asked that something be done. President Schulman suggested that she stay until after the meeting, and someone who can help would talk to her. Patricia Kirk announced that the Tree Commission will not be meeting in July, but will meet the first Tuesday in August, and said she is looking forward to working with Member Scaglione, who is the Council representative for the Tree Commission. Linda Campbell spoke about the problem with high grass in the vacant lot across the street from her residence. She has tried to reach someone in Code regarding this property, but can never get through to anyone. She would also like to see a recreation center in the park near her home so people may hold events there and kids will have a place to go and things to do. She also feels there should be more jobs available, which would help stop crime. James Parker spoke about the Marathon rezone. He reiterated some of Mr. O'Brien's concerns from the public hearing, and said that Marathon should purchase the lot from Mr. O'Brien, compensate him for his time and trouble, and move him off the property. He asked Council to deny the rezone request, and stipulate that the rezoning contain Mr. O'Brien's property and that he be adequately compensated. Jolanda Jackson is concerned about problems she experienced in the southeast end, and feels the only answer is prayer. She has asked for ward maps so she can set up leadership in each ward where the churches can come out. She has been trying to get these maps for almost a year, but has been unsuccessful. She asked Council to provide her with a copy of the ward maps, and challenged everyone to step up as leaders, come out to the different wards, and address these problems.
