# OLD BUSINESS (PUBLIC SPEAKS): None

**PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS):** Katherine Baylock is concerned about the condition of the property at 322 Cornelia Avenue NE. She has made numerous complaints regarding the high grass and the deteriorating structure, and invites Council Members to drive by and view it. She heard that Bill Smuckler is the man to see to get the job done. Michael Steward is concerned about the Everhard Road exit ramp going east. He recommended eliminating one exit ramp to avoid traffic problems. Jan Schueler brought in some stones from the chip and seal on her road. She said the road should be swept four hours after the chip and seal, then again a day or two later. Her street was not swept. Also, a chip and seal road causes noise from the tires, is dusty, and she has seen weeds coming up through the chip and seal. She suggested slurry seal which uses much smaller stones. Dave Fetters is against chip and seal because of the loose stones. He said the stones are brought into the house on people's shoes, you can't walk barefoot, and as he indicated last week, his son runs out into the street to play with the stones. He asked again if something is going to be done about Tanya Johnson's vacant house. Member Smith said she did see the house and will talk to Mr. Fetters after the meeting. He feels that somebody needs to take care of these lawns. Brenda Baylor doesn't understand the mathematics involved with chip and seal. She's heard that 17 roads can be chipped and sealed for every one that is paved. She believes the pay and cost of equipment would still be the same. She would rather they leave the streets alone until they could be paved. Paving enhances the beauty of the whole street.
