PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Pat Varn, who serves on the Montabella Board of Directors, spoke about the installation of the Verizon tower on First Friends Church parking lot, adjacent to their wetlands. The tower will reduce their beautiful view, along with their property value by up to 20%. She's asked Council to use their influence to convince Verizon to co-locate their cell service with AT&T, on the water tower across from the church. Brenda Baylor spoke about the issues that the surrounding neighbors have been having with Republic Steel. Most people assume that this issue has been dropped and that no one cares because they're not getting any response from Council and the Administration. The only people who have received any information are her and Mr. Zachary. She would like a meeting to be held to get the information out to all 8000 people who are affected. Don Johnson, who is with the Affairs of the Community, wanted to know what's coming from the smokestacks at Republic Steel. He said there's been a white substance covering the resident's cars and homes in the Georgeview Estates community. The substance is also blowing towards the school and the children are breathing it in. He said the residents are considering taking a trip to Columbus with their complaints about Republic Steel, but would rather get results here, from Council and Administration. John Alge thanked Members Mariol and Hawk for their work with the former Lehman School building. Although there was a presentation given about plans for the building that was very positive, he would like to receive some additional information.
