## OLD BUSINESS (PUBLIC SPEAKS): None

PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Brenda Baylor spoke to a person from the EPA regarding the Republic Steel issue. She asked about lead levels and was told that they're very confusing and that they can vary from place to place. They are currently looking into holding an open meeting with all homeowners surrounding Republic Steel. Ms. Baylor was informed that someone affiliated with Republic Steel has been going over to the new Air Monitoring System at 2:00 - 3:00 in the morning and turning the system off. She passed this information on to Health Commissioner, Jim Adams, who said his Dept. will investigate. Lisa Gissendaner spoke about the closing of the two Fisher Foods grocery stores, on Harrison Ave. SW and Cherry Ave. NE. Both stores are in areas considered under-served populations. She said there are food deserts within the city, specifically the S.E. and N.E. quadrants which have no access to fresh produce, fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, or meats. Instead, those areas have the "Dollar" themed stores (Dollar General, Dollar Tree and Family Dollar). Although those stores sell nothing but processed, sugar filled, expired foods, and foods that have empty calories and nutrients which contributes to the health disparities, they are deemed grocery stores by the state only because they sell bread and milk. She asked what can be done to try to get Fisher Foods to reconsider, redevelop and upgrade their services for those most in need, and if not, she would like to know what Council's plan is for the city. Joe Shaheen spoke about the lack of a speed limit sign and adequate lighting at McKinley Avenue, south of 12<sup>th</sup> St. He believes first appearances are very crucial and that the road isn't very attractive. He would like to see flashing lights as well as a "Welcome to Downtown Canton" sign to extend over the top of the road at the entrance of McKinley Avenue. He believes it would bring positivity in the revitalization of this great city.
