PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Chuck Osborne spoke about problems with the Hall of Fame Village. He is concerned about the location so close to Avondale and how it will affect property values. He questioned who will pay for replacing McKinley High School and rebuilding the Fulton/I-77 interchange. He also fears it may be the demise of the McKinley Grand Hotel. Brain injuries suffered in football is a concern and this has been acknowledged by the NFL. Pete DiGiacomo read an article from the January 28, 2018 issue of The Repository regarding overtime costs for police and fire. He stated that the Hall of Fame was to pay a portion of these costs, and the City if still waiting for payment. The City pays their moral obligations, so should the Hall of Fame. Ken Jones spoke about the potential income tax increase to fund the Comprehensive Plan. He feels that plans which provide for housing renewal should come first. Certain areas for revitalization should be specified and what the focus will be, including a ranking of importance. He feels homeowners should be involved in the decision making process, and zoning should be modified and enforced so that low quality, subsidized housing may not be erected indiscriminately anywhere in the City. He would like to see a city wide property tax easement proposed to give homeowners an incentive to reinvest in their homes.
