MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Smith moved that Council Rules 15B and 15H be waived so George Lancaster may finish his presentation. (Voice vote: all in favor) ** George Lancaster expressed concern that everyone should be aware and educated about the affects of diabetes in the City of Canton. He again mentioned that they are in conjunction and working with the American Diabetes Association and Mercy Medical Center, as well as the Hall of Fame to spread the awareness even more. He stated that 193,000 people under the age of 20 and 29 million Americans overall are affected by diabetes. When Charles Harris and Malik Hooker heard about the death of his nephew, Tyler Scott Lancaster, they became involved and collaborated with more NFL players to help spread the word about diabetes. He asked for Council's support with their endeavors, and stated that they would like to establish a Diabetes Clinic, possibly at the Southeast Community Center. He announced that there will be a free Diabetes Awareness Dinner on March 24th for all diabetic patients. If anyone has any questions, he will be happy to stay after the meeting to answer them. Member Smuckler stated that the reason he had to sustain a quadruple by-pass last year was because of diabetes. He encouraged everyone to read labels. Diabetes is a hidden killer, and he offered to help as much as possible. Member Morris stated that his daughter was a victim of juvenile diabetes, and he has the deepest sympathy for Mr. Lancaster and his family for what they've gone through. He would like to be actively involved in providing any resources they may need. Mr. Lancaster announced that they are starting two summer programs, a Diabetes Institute for Juniors and Seniors in high school and a Diabetes Kids Camp, which will begin on June 20th through June 29th at the Southeast Community Center. Member Minor Smith thanked Council for allowing Mr. Lancaster to speak. She advised that any property around 631 or 635 Alan Page Dr is owned and operated by Canton Somerset LP, and not SMHA. There are many multi-family developments throughout Canton that are subsidized housing that are not owned by SMHA. If anyone would like more information regarding property owners, or if there are issues or problems, she will be glad to address those.
