PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Kim Horton spoke against the AirBNB at 1258 11th St SW. She is concerned because this is a residential neighborhood for single family dwellings, it is not meant for businesses and parking is a problem. The owners are currently taking reservations without yet having permission. Marjorie Burkhart lives across from the AirBNB at 1258 11th St SW. She is concerned because she has observed many young ladies soliciting in this area, and also parking is a major issue. Brenda Baylor spoke about the proposed building of slab homes in Georgeview Estates. She believes that Georgeview Estates has been a shining improvement to Canton, and their homes will be devalued if slab homes are built. She is asking Council to back them up on their restrictions and not allow the builders to put up homes without concrete foundations. Pete Carpcio is also concerned about slab homes being built in Georgeview Estates which will devalue their neighborhood. If this happens, their only option will be to file a lawsuit which will be after the fact and nothing will change. He asked that Council, being their leadership, does everything in its power to make sure this does not happen. John Stone spoke about Nimisilla Park and explained that Nimisilla is Native American for "Meeting Tree." The park is bordered by four city wards, 2, 4, 6 and 9, making it the heart of Canton. Many historic events have taken place there. He invited everyone to contact him with ideas for the Park, and announced that BEarth Day is Saturday, May 12th, at 10:00 A.M. They will be planting flowers and cleaning up, along with a community picnic. Everyone is welcome to join.
