PUBLIC SPEAKS (CITY BUSINESS): Renee Pilone stated that it's been over a year now since the prohibition on AirBnB's. Because of this legislation, she has lost thousands of dollars of rental income and the City has lost income tax revenue and lodging taxes. She mentioned the many things that bring people to Canton such as the Hall of Fame expansion and the Arts District. However, the prohibition on AirBnB's is hurting businesses and tourism in Canton. Data shows that AirBnB's attract new visitors who stay twice as long as traditional tourists, spend more on local businesses and are more likely to return. She asked that Council re-examine the issue of AirBnB's for the upcoming tourism season.
