MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Member Smuckler said that social media should just be for social media and not for grandiose announcements to be made. There's such misinformation out there. He hoped no one misses their opportunity to vote because the election is too important. He suggested letting the news media handle their own sources rather than social media dictating whether there will be an election or not. He also corrected a social media post by stating that although it may not have been the clearest message, notices were put in all envelopes with bills stating that the Water Dept. was going to monthly billing. They will be charged at the same rates whether you pay once a month, every other month or each quarter. He commended the Health Department for keeping everyone abreast of what's going on and proclaimed that "We will weather this storm like we've weathered so many other storms." He urged everyone to ask their favorite restaurants if they're doing carryout and to support them because their workers live on minimum wage and tips. He encouraged everyone not to be upset if items that they need aren't at the grocery stores right now. Items are being restocked but it's taking some time. He finished by saying that he will see everyone back next week whether there's an Ordinance on the Agenda or not, even if it's just to say hello.

QUOTE OF THE WEEK: "We are getting a lot of reports of a lot of stigma being placed on Mercy Medical Center healthcare workers. That is a huge shame. We need to support those who will be providing care for our loved ones, not excluding them from coffee shops and other public places. As we prepare for an increase in cases in Ohio and here in our community, we must pull together. Don't be part of the problem. Get the facts, first. Educate more, fear less." - Jim Adams, Canton Public Health Commissioner
