MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Majority Leader Smuckler stated that he and President Sherer have received numerous calls and complaints regarding pre-registering for the COVID-19 vaccine. He introduced Health Commissioner Adams, who gave an update on the COVID-19 vaccine and answered questions from Council Members. There is a lot of concern with not getting calls back from the company that is registering people. A call back is critical to know if you're on the list for the vaccine. Commissioner Adams informed Council that there are other community providers, in addition to the Health Dept. giving the vaccine, such as Marc's, Giant Eagle, Drug Mart and the local hospitals. More providers mean greater access; however, some of the current providers are not in Canton's highest area of need and there is an uncertainty of the vaccine allocation from week to week. Member Smith announced that the Hartford Bulldogs Basketball Team remain undefeated, with two games left. She also announced a food give-away for Saturday, February 13th at the Southeast Community Center, from 1:00 – 4:00. The program is sponsored by a group called Canton out of Canton.
