The critical need to continuously recruit and test for safety personnel, coupled with the additional recruitment efforts both onsite and offsite, has created the need for one additional Recruitment and Marketing Specialist to assist with these increased responsibilities.

Therefore, we hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Amends Ordinance #100/2011 and establishes Exhibit A as the Classification Plan for the Civil Service Department.
- 2. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.

The City of Canton Fire Department applied for and has been awarded the 2024 Ambulance Transportation Program, administered by OBM. The awarded amount is \$23,914.53 which represents \$160.00 per first responder. The grant performance period ends 6/30/2024. The funds are to be used for premium pay for first responders.

Bargaining unit members (other than those leaving due to years of service retirements or disability retirements) who are no longer employed with the city of Canton as a firefighter/ paramedic as of December 31, 2024, shall repay 100% of the grant funds (less withholdings and Medicare contributions) to the city of Canton.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Authorizes the Mayor and/or the Director of Public Safety to accept \$23,914.53 in grant funds from the 2024 Ohio Ambulance Transportation Program.

#### RE: 105.04 Emergency Report – 2318 13th St NE Commercial Warehouse

Dear Madam President and Honorable Members:

Pursuant to Section 105.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Canton, I am hereby advising you of a situation that requires the use of the City's emergency contractual procedures. The property located at 2318 13<sup>th</sup> St NE owned by **Zachary M. Stewart** was deemed "Unsafe" by Chief Building Official Charles J. Corcoran after being inspected by the City of Canton Building Department. The unsafe conditions are a direct result of a fire that took place on 2-8-2024, that imposed severe damage to the location;

#### Parcel: #285995; Legal Description: OL 1321 - 1.22A

"The Chief Building Official hereby deems the building an unsafe structure in actual, immediate, and imminent danger of failure or collapse. Given the unstable condition of this building and the potential for damage to people and/or property, the Chief Building Official declares this an emergency condition requiring immediate attention. The Chief Building Official is hereby authorized to cause the necessary work to be done to render this building or part thereof temporarily safe. This property is unsafe to enter for testing."

It is unlawful for any person to enter or use this structure except for the purpose of securing the structure, making the required repairs, removing the hazardous condition, or demolishing the same.

Pursuant to CCO 1301.17, APPEAL OF CHIEF BUILDING OFFICIAL'S DECISION; EXCEPTION, due to requiring immediate action, this Order cannot be appealed to the Board of Building Appeals."

With this determination process being followed, CRS Contracting was selected from our contractor rotation list to remediate the property and submitted a cost of \$32,000.00 to complete a RACM demolition. The building was safely razed and all charges incurred by the city will be pursued through the Canton Law Department from the owner, **Zachary M. Stewart**.



Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Ratifies all actions taken prior to the passage of this ordinance pursuant to Section 105.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Canton.
- 2. Authorizes the Mayor and/or the Director of Public Safety to enter into any and all contracts necessary to respond to the above emergency situation.
- 3. Authorizes and directs the City of Canton Auditor to pay any and all moral obligations resulting from responding to this emergency situation.
- 4. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.
