RE: Hall of Fame Village Loan Restructuring

Dear Madam President and Honorable Members:

The Hall of Fame Village (HOFV) has requested that the City of Canton, Stark Community Foundation, and the Stark County Port Authority restructure their existing loans. This request has been made due to consistent delays regarding their ability to secure the necessary financing for the completion of the Waterpark & Hotel. These continued shortfalls in capital raising have resulted in the depletion of operational cash that is needed to maintain operations at the HOFV. This has resulted in an immediate need for the City of Canton to respond and assist through the restructuring of debt to provide cash flow relief and to extend near term debt.

As way of background, Canton City Council authorized the City of Canton to enter into two loan agreements with the HOFV. These separate loans provided necessary gap financing for the DoubleTree Hotel and the Hall of Fame Village infrastructure. The City of Canton loaned \$3.5MM at a rate of .5% for the DoubleTree Hotel and \$5MM at a rate of 6% for the infrastructure at HOFV. The loans mature and come due in 2030 (DoubleTree) and 2029 (HOFV infrastructure). The current structure of these notes results in a bubble payment of each in those respective years; this is consistent with the other loans which have been made by Stark Community Foundation and the Stark County Port Authority. The size of balloon payments which come due within the next five years creates hesitancy for investors to purchase the necessary TIF and TDD bonds for the project. Therefore, we are suggesting loan modifications upon the following terms for both loans:

- Deferment of all payments and interest until July 1, 2026
- Principle & Interest (P & I) payments shall commence on July 1, 2026 for a 20-year term
- 5% interest rate for both loans

Under the current agreements, the City of Canton was set to make approximately \$1.65MM in interest on top of the \$8.5MM in principle (\$10.15MM in total payments). With the proposed restructuring, the City of Canton will make approximately \$4.8MM in new interest plus the \$540,000 which has already been collected. This would bring the total paid amount to the City to \$13.84MM over the life of the loans.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation which does the following:

1. Authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service to enter into loan modification agreements, and any other necessary agreements, with HOF Village Hotel II LLC and

Hall of Fame Resort and Entertainment Company for the restructuring of the DoubleTree Hotel and HOFV Infrastructure Loans.

2. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.

We have reached the time of year that some appropriation clean ups need to occur. I have come across multiple items that need some attention. The goal is to have this done in one (1) ordinance rather than 4 or 5 ordinances. The appropriation changes will be outlined below.

- 1. Appropriations are needed in Fund 4505 2022 Infrastructure Bond Fund to assist in the creation of a PO for the 2024 paving program which has funding from various funds.
- 2. Ordinance no. 72/2024 appropriated \$23,914.53 into a personnel account as a grant was received for an ARPA bonus for the Fire Department. Instead of paying each fire person out of a personnel account the Auditors office will pay for the bonus out of our regular fire expense account and then move the grant monies as a reimbursable for this transaction. In order to make this happen we need to do an appropriation transfer from personnel to other.
- 3. The City and the Hall of Fame Village are involved in a number of complex transactions as it pertains to Tax Increment Financing, Tourism Development District income and PACE financing. Appropriations for these transactions are difficult to predict at the begging of the year, which requires us to be flexible and to adjust when necessary. It is now time to adjust some appropriations for 2024 so that we can pay out these financial obligations.
- 4. The City has been working with SOL Harris/Day to come up with a budget to allow for some previously approved renovations to the Canton Memorial Civic Center with Ordinance no 211/2023. These renovations include electrical work, plumbing work, HVAC replacements, audio visual improvements etc. The funding mechanism for this project is going to be ARPA Revenue Loss dollars through the ARPA program. In order to use ARPA Revenue Loss dollars we will need to create appropriations in the general fund and then get reimbursed from our ARPA Fund to the General Fund.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation which does the following in order to complete the above listed projects:

RE: Legislation Request – Appropriation of Loan Funds for Water Service Shop Renovation Project

Dear Madam President and Honorable Members:

Ordinance 221/2023 gave permission to advertise, receive bids, award and execute all contracts for the Water Services Shop Renovation Project. The project was advertised and bids were received. The lowest and best bid for the construction portion was received from Mike Coates Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$5,979,428.00. The construction bid has been sent to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) and the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) for review and loan award.

The Water Department had initially estimated the total project cost to be \$11,000,000.00, but the current cost estimate for the project construction is \$7,087,230.00. To fund this project, \$5,000,000.00 has been appropriated from the 5201 Water Fund, and the remaining balance will be funded through a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), through the Ohio Water Development Authority. The Water Department will be requesting a low interest loan to be amortized over a 10-year period. Current rates have dropped to 2.6 % although this could be adjusted by the time the loan is finalized.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Authorizes the Auditor to receive all loan and revenue proceeds and track project expenses in the 5252 Water Service Shop Renovation Fund in the amount of \$2,087,230.00.
- 2. Makes the following supplemental appropriations amending Ordinance 61/2024 as amended:

FROM: Unappropriated 5252 Wtr Svs Shop Bld Renov Fund

(\$2,087,230,00)

TO: 5252 207079 Wtr Svs Shop Bld Renov Fund – Other

\$2,087,230.00

3. Authorizes the Auditor to draw warrants upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

4. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.

Funding is scheduled to be awarded by the Ohio Water Development Authority on May 30, 2024. The contracts cannot be certified without the above appropriation. As such, I am respectfully requesting this ordinance be considered for passage on second reading at Council's May 20, 2024 meeting. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
