This proposed replat is in line with the theories presented in the Comprehensive Plan. This replat will result in neighborhood investment in the development of brand new housing, and at no cost to the city.


Therefore, I am respectfully requesting that legislation be enacted to authorize the subject replat of said property.

### **RE:** Request for Legislation –Non-Bargaining Civil Service Employee Wage Increase

Dear Madame President and Honorable Members:

On behalf of the Civil Service Commission, I am respectfully requesting that City Council approve a 5% pay increase for Adamaris Cortes, a current Recruitment & Marketing Specialist for the Civil Service Department. The Civil Service Department recently hired an additional Recruitment & Marketing Specialist to assist with recruitment efforts, particularly for safety forces, and in an effort to get the best qualified candidate we offered said person the minimum rate plus ten percent (10%), the maximum allowed without requiring Council approval. The Civil Service Commission wants to maintain a small range between the new hire and the current employee (Ms. Cortes) to be reflective of their years of experience in the position. Ms. Cortes currently makes \$50,264. A five percent (5%) increase would amount to \$2,513 per year.

Furthermore, over the past year Ms. Cortes has demonstrated a unique ability and skillset that has greatly contributed to the significant increase in the City's online recruitment presence for the City of Canton. The Commission feels that this increase is therefore also justly deserved.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Sets the salary of Recruitment & Marketing Specialist Adamaris Cortes at 5% above her current salary as of the passage of this ordinance.
- 2. Authorizes the Auditor to draw warrants upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- 3. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.




