MEMBER DOUGHERTY: Mr. President, Public Property Capital Improvement will also meet that evening at 6:30.

PUBLIC SPEAKS (OPEN FORUM--CITY BUSINESS ONLY)

PRESIDENT DENCZAK: Once again, no one signed up for Public Speaks under this portion of the meeting.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

PRESIDENT DENCZAK: We're now under Miscellaneous Business, now. Is there any miscellaneous business?...

MEMBER GRIFFIN: Mr. President, I'd like to remind Council and the gallery that this Friday, the Canton Ex Newsboys will be out on the corners selling their papers so that no child shall miss school for the lack of shoes or clothing. I had the edition here, it's the latest, I picked them up today. If you'd like to..you know, I have a can also. Just happen to have one. If you feel uncomfortable, I have envelopes here that you can take home and mail your check in to me later. Unfortunately, we don't take credit cards. But I'd be more than happy to oblige you today. Thank you, sir.

PRESIDENT DENCZAK: Member Griffin, if you're going to put commercials out here, I gotta take some money for it.

MEMBER GRIFFIN: I was under 3 minutes, wasn't I?

PRESIDENT DENCZAK: A 3-minute commercial on WHBC...I don't know, 50 bucks? I already sent a check. I already sent a check to Mr. Roach. Is there any miscellaneous business?

MEMBER HAWK: Mr. President, I have a question for our Safety Director Hunt. Last February, our Chief Building Official resigned to take another position. Since then we have been without a Chief Building Official. I was wondering where we stand on that process. We have been paying an outside, under service contract, an outside consultant to handle those duties at this time. I feel a city this size should require a Chief Building Official so we can conduct business in an orderly fashion.

SAFETY DIRECTOR HUNT: Mr. President, initially the City of Canton advertised for that position. We weren't able to obtain anyone who was actually interested for the amount of money that we had available. So the Mayor along with other private industry decided to get a focus group together. We've been meeting diligently. Last week we spoke to managers from Wood County and from Claremont County where all of the cities and villages got together in the county, and they have one building department. We have scheduled meetings with Massillon, Alliance and North Canton to review their building department and bring back some information. It is our hopes we'll be able to talk to other governments and maybe combine building departments. But we haven't arrived at a decision yet.

MEMBER HAWK: Mr. Hunt, thank you so much for that explanation. I truly appreciate it.

PRESIDENT DENCZAK: Is there any other miscellaneous business?

MEMBER CASAR: Mr. President, I move we adjourn; seconded.

PRESIDENT DENCZAK: Moved and seconded that you adjourn; roll call vote please.
