RECOGNIZING ARBOR DAY APRIL 26, 2019

- WHEREAS,** Arbor Day was established in 1872 by J. Sterling Morton and the Nebraska Board of Agriculture; and
- WHEREAS,** Arbor Day is designated as a special day to advocate for trees in our community, promote respect for the environment, and encourage individuals to give back to the planet by beautifying the nation's landscape with trees; and
- WHEREAS,** the benefits of activism on Arbor Day are observed throughout the world as citizens give back to the environment by improving their neighborhoods' landscapes through the means of planting and protecting trees; and
