

WHO CAN APPLY TO TAKE THE POLICE OFFICER EXAMINATION

To apply, you must meet the following qualifications:

You must be at least 21 years of age before November 4, 2014 and you must be appointed before your 35th birthday.
NO POLICE OFFICER CAN BE APPOINTED AFTER THEY TURN 35. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.

You must possess a valid driver's license issued by your state of residence.

You must be a high school graduate or possess a GED.

You must be a citizen of the United States.

You must never have been convicted of a felony.

You must have vision correctable to 20/20 and normal color vision.

Fill out the special police officer application completely.

WHAT NEEDS TURNED IN WITH THE APPLICATION

A clear copy of your driver's license (if you apply in person, we can copy it for you, but if you are mailing your application to us, you will need to enclose a copy)

A \$20 filing fee (cash, checks, money orders only made out to the "City of Canton") **WE CANNOT ACCEPT CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS**

10" x 13" self-addressed, stamped catalog envelope (address the envelope to yourself and put \$3.32 postage on it)
THIS IS ONLY FOR PEOPLE WHO WILL BE APPLYING BY MAIL SO WE MAY MAIL YOU BACK YOUR STUDY GUIDE.

WHAT NEEDS TURNED IN AFTER YOU PASS THE WRITTEN EXAM

High School Grade Transcripts (this doesn't need turned in with the preliminary application, but sometimes takes a while, so you may consider requesting them now).

Bonus Credit Documentation & Standards (these are all listed in detail on the job announcement that you printed out)

Agreement and Release (this form is on our website and must be filled out and turned in prior to participating in physical agility)

Certification and Waiver of Liability (this form is on our website and must be filled out and turned in prior to participating in physical agility)

Doctor's permission slip (you will need to show a physician of your choice the physical agility test that you printed out and have him fill out on his letterhead or prescription paper written permission that you are physically able to participate in the physical agility test). Must be turned in prior to participating in physical agility exam.
