Scholarship Level – Full Tuition

Scholarships Offered – 14

Requirements:

- Must be a resident of the City of Canton and attend a public school for a full year prior to application
- Must complete letter of inquiry to Mayor's Office and receive a letter of recommendation from the Mayor's Office
- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
(PELL will be applied if applicable)
- Must apply to be a full time student
- Must maintain good academic standing
- Deadline to apply – April 15
- Renewable for up to full tuition for two (2) consecutive years

Categories of Scholarship Opportunities:

Stark State College will make fourteen total scholarships available to students who live within the City of Canton under the following categories:

- Canton City Schools Valedictorian and Salutatorian:

<i>Valedictorian and Salutatorian - McKinley High School</i>	= 2
<i>Valedictorian and Salutatorian - Timken High School</i>	= 2
<i>Valedictorian and Salutatorian - GlenOak High School</i>	= 2
<i>Valedictorian and Salutatorian - Canton South High School</i>	= 2
<i>Valedictorian and Salutatorian - East Canton High School</i>	= 2

- Canton City Schools Early College High School = 2
- Canton City Schools Students of Promise = 2

(Students with GPA of 2.0 – 2.9 along with
Teacher Recommendation)
