Mayors' Scholarship Program

- Criteria
  - First-time full-time freshman
    - 2010 high school graduate
      - Current year graduate for subsequent years
    - High school cumulative grade point average 3.3
    - Rank top 15% of class
    - Minimum test score
      - ACT = 18
      - SAT = 830 (verbal + math)
  - Must have filed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2010-11 academic year and be PELL Grant eligible
  - 2 scholarships per year
    - Maximum of 8 during any academic term
  - Must obtain a letter of recommendation from the Mayor's office to submit with their scholarship application
  - Must be a resident of the City of Canton since the beginning of the school year.
  - Only available to a public school and lives within the city limits
- Mayor's Scholarship recipient's financial aid award
  - The recipient will receive a total financial aid award equal to the cost of tuition (\$20,550 for the 2009-10 academic year).
    - Financial award will be a compilation of
      - Scholarships
        - Walsh University (\$7,000 - \$10,000)
        - Mayor's Scholarship (\$5,000)
      - Grants need-based (amounts vary depending on financial need)

  - Pell Grant
  - Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant (SEOG)
- Loans
  - Direct Stafford loan
    - Maximum of \$5,500
